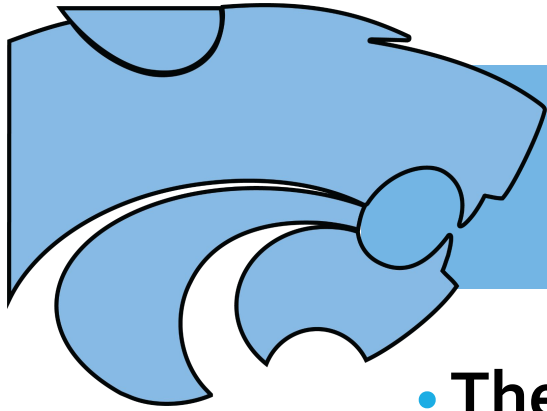

# GPA CALCULATION

- A = 4.0
- A- = 3.7
- B+ = 3.3
- B = 3.0
- B- = 2.7
- C+ = 2.3
- C = 2.0
- C- = 1.7
- D+ = 1.3
- D = 1.0
- F = 0.0

Honors, Level 4/5 Language and other select courses weighted = +.5

Ex: B+ in honors = 3.8

AP and Dual Enrolled courses weighted = +1.0

Ex: B in AP = 4.0



# ECONOMICS & PERSONAL FINANCE

- Standard EPF - during the school year
- EPF Honors – during the school year
- AP Micro/Macro – during the school year
- Self-Directed online option during the school year as an 8<sup>th</sup> period course (has tuition fee) – Pass/Fail only
- Summer self-directed online (has tuition fee) – Pass/Fail Only
- Standard summer online course (has tuition fee)
- Summer Choices – Recommended to take the WISE exam in EPF

# FACTORS TO CONSIDER

- What is the diploma type I want? – Standard or Advanced
- What subjects interest me the most? – Think of what you want to do after high school and your interests.
- Do I have a strong foundation for the next course? – Consider your previous level of success in that subject area.
- Am I ready for the challenge of AP and Honors? – Consider your study habits.
- Are there pre-requisites for the courses I want to take? Pre-requisites are requirements you need before you take a course.
  - Grade Level (Juniors and Seniors only)
  - Previous Course Requirement (Art 1 before Art 2)
  - Teacher Recommendations
  - Auditions (Band, Chorus, Orchestra, Guitar)

# EARNING COLLEGE CREDIT

- **Concurrent Enrollment** - allows qualified high school students to take college courses at NOVA or the college/university while enrolled in high school to earn college credit and possibly receive high school credit for these courses. [Form IS-158](#) and the specific NOVA, college/university forms must be completed/approved prior to registration.
- **Dual Enrollment** – Courses taught at the high school by an FCPS teacher and offer college credit through agreements with NOVA or a college/university. Speak with your counselor if you want to learn more about this option and the registration process.
- **Dual Enrollment Courses Offered at CVHS** – English 12, Geospatial Analysis, Latin 4, Multivariable Calculus/Matrix Algebra, Biology 2 DE, US Government DE, and Entrepreneurship. Other Dual Enrolled courses available at the academy and Online Campus.

- Online course selection in Student Vue – students will receive instructions on how to select a draft of your courses in your Student Vue account during ROAR.
- Parents can review student course selections in the Parent Vue account.
- Master schedule is based on selections by mid March – choose wisely!
- Electives and level changes will be considered until June 14<sup>th</sup> – if space is available.
- Schedules are created in June/July/August.
- Schedules will be given out at the Wildcat Welcome in August.
