□ Virginia Tech

- Apply through Coalition Application
- No recommendation letters
- Self-report grades and test scores
- No secondary choice of major offered
- Early Action is now an option in addition to Early Decision and Regular
- 4 mandatory short answer questions (120 words max)
- MS classes that earned HS credit should be reported

□ George Mason

- Accepting unofficial test scores for admissions and scholarship applications
