- Bring your completed All Night Grad Party forms or pick up forms at the meeting. These forms must be completed before your student can attend the All-Night Grad Party.
- Purchase 2018 **graduation yard signs** for \$20
- Order **Mulch** for your yard. All online orders must be placed by Sunday, April 15<sup>th</sup> at midnight and the mail-in sales deadline is Tuesday, April 17<sup>th</sup> at noon. The 3 cubic foot bags of shredded hardwood mulch are \$5 per bag for 1-49 bags and \$4.60 for 50+ bags. Free delivery is provided on orders of 10 bags or more.
- Sign-up to **volunteer** during Mulch weekend April 5-7
- Volunteer to feed the workers during mulch weekend
- Meet with our **Balfour** representative to place any last-minute orders of invitations, a class ring or senior wear.
- Pick up an order form for **graduation DVD's**
- Get ready for **Prom!** We will have discount coupons from tuxedo rental stores, information on prom dress sales, limousines to check out in front of the school (!) at our event for you to get ideas for our upcoming Prom on June 1st at The Sheraton Hotel in Reston.
