

CENTREVILLE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT PARKING RULES

2020 – 2021

Only students who have purchased a Parking Permit may park on school grounds and only in their assigned parking space.

Parking violations include:

- Non-display of permit from the rear view mirror or dashboard
- Students may not park in any spaces reserved for Staff/Faculty
- Improper transfer of a permit;
 - Students may not trade their issued permit
 - Students may not give away their issued permit
 - Students may not sell their issued permit
- Parking in fire lanes and handicapped spaces without authorization

Fines:

All parking violations will result in a fine of \$25.00 for the first offense, \$50.00 for the second and or subsequent offense. For repeated violations or non-payment of fines the vehicle will be booted or towed to a storage facility, incurring any additional charger's and fees that the tow company may impose. This may also result in the revocation of the parking permit without refund. Fines not paid will go on the student's debt list and that student will not be able to purchase tickets for or attend functions such as Homecoming, Prom, Etc. as well as other sanctions imposed by the School Administration.

Tardies:

- Any student who is tardy (EXCUSED or UNEXCUSED) five times to First and or Second period within a quarter **will lose their parking privileges for ten school days.**
- Any additional tardy to this period within the quarter will also **result in loss of parking privileges for ten school days.**

Leaving Campus:

- Students are not permitted to leave the school campus during the school day without properly signing-out through the Attendance Office. Any student who uses a vehicle to leave school grounds without authorization (leaving during lunch, cutting class, etc.) will have their permit suspended for 30 days in addition to any other disciplinary action deemed appropriate.
