**The University of Mary Washington is offering on-site admissions for seniors on Thursday, December 5 in the College & Career Center.** Students must complete the common application to UMW no later than December 2, 2019. Students must bring an unofficial copy of the high school transcript showing senior year courses as well as a copy of SAT/ACT scores if not applying test choice. **NOVA Pathways has extended their application deadline to Friday, November 15<sup>th</sup> at 11:59 pm.** NOVA Counselor Ms. Gomez will be in the College & Career Center on MONDAY, November 11<sup>th</sup> all day to help students complete their application. **George Mason University has extended their Early Action (EA) application deadline to November 15<sup>th</sup>.** Students who apply by Nov. 15<sup>th</sup> will still be given priority consideration for the Honors College and merit scholarships. Students who apply EA will receive an admission decision from GMU by mid-December.

The **Centreville High School PTSA offers 5 very generous scholarships to graduating seniors every year (\$1,000 each).** The application is due in the spring, **but in order to apply SENIORS must be student members of the CVHS PTSA by DECEMBER 1.** This cannot be listed in Naviance because the membership costs \$10. Dues support school programs, educational grants, and graduation celebrations among other school-wide initiatives.
