SAT Scores for FCPS Students Continue to Exceed State and National Averages - Fairfax County Public Schools seniors in the class of 2019 continued the trend of surpassing state and national averages on the SAT, according to results released by the College Board. The FCPS mean score for 2019 was 1,218, nearly 100 points above Virginia (1,119) and more than 150 points above the U.S. (1,059). This FCPS overall average is also up slightly from 1,213 in 2018.
