Seniors will participate in the EXPLORE NOVA program and receive information about first-year academic advising, financial aid, and campus involvement. **This will include a tour and boxed lunch!** The field trip will be capped at 45 students on a first-come, first-serve basis. Please pick up a permission form in the College & Career Center and turn them in no later than March 17.

The **ASVAB** is a timed multi-aptitude test, which is given at over 14,000 schools and Military Entrance Processing Stations (MEPS) nationwide. It is a helpful career assessment tool which is developed and maintained by the Department of Defense. There is no obligation to join the military if you choose to take the ASVAB.
