**Bills advance that would expand access to in-state tuition regardless of citizenship status** - "The state Senate and the House have advanced bills to make students living in the U.S. without documentation eligible for in-state tuition. SB 935, introduced by Democratic Sens. Jennifer Boysko and Ghazala Hashmi, would require a student to provide proof of filed taxes to be eligible for in-state tuition," [reports Virginia Business](#).
