The ASVAB is a timed multi-aptitude test, which is given at over 14,000 schools and Military Entrance Processing Stations (MEPS) nationwide. It is a helpful career assessment tool which is developed and maintained by the Department of Defense. There is no obligation to join the military if you choose to take the ASVAB. Juniors and seniors should complete this [form](#) to register for the ASVAB at Centreville High School on Thursday, December 9, 2021. Students must report to the Lecture Hall at 8:15am and the assessment will begin promptly at 8:30am.
