The <u>Institute for Excellence</u> is a free six-week academic enrichment summer bridge program at George Mason's Fairfax Campus. Students will have the ability to earn college credit from a host of disciplines that include STEM, Humanities, Health Sciences, Education, Sports Management, and Business. The program is a hybrid with a blend of virtual and inperson learning. Students will also engage in research, college success, and career readiness programming.

Deadline: Students interested must review the eligibility requirements, program dates included on the <u>program flyer</u>, and apply by May 5, 2023.
