Class of 2024 – Get Ready for Senior Year! Mark your calendar for a presentation on Wednesday, May 31 during PLUS to learn more about college application specifics such as transcript request process, recommendations, counselor questionnaires, essays, and how to use your summer wisely. Students with last names A-K will be in the auditorium during the first part of PLUS, L-Z for the second half.

The U.S. Department of Education published an update of the <u>College Scorecard</u>. The updates include a more user-friendly interface that aims to make the scorecard more accessible to students, families, and educators.

NOVA's <u>Early Online College</u> (EOC) gives qualified high school juniors (Class of 2025) and seniors (Class of 2024) an opportunity to take up to two online tuition-free courses to earn transferable college only credits. Fall 2023 EOC courses run from September 18-December 12, 2023. NOVA is also launching a <u>Career Studies Certificate</u> through Early Online College for 5 industry certifications!
