<u>VCU announced a new guaranteed university admission program</u> for first-year freshmen who have a weighted GPA of 3.5 or higher. Note that some programs, such as arts and engineering, will have major-specific requirements and are not eligible for this program. Check out the <u>FAQ</u> for more details.

The <u>JMU Centennial Scholars Program</u> is now open! This scholarship covers the **FULL COST** of in-state tuition, fees, housing and meals for **first generation Pell Grant eligible students**. Incoming first year students must demonstrate high performance in a rigorous course load. Deadline is February 1, 2024. Email <u>centscholars@jmu.edu</u> with questions.

The <u>Two-Night Virtual Post-Secondary Event</u> will be hosted by FCPS on Oct. 16-17. The workshops include Paying for College, Military 101, Standardized Testing in the College Process, Scholarship 101, NOVA Options, Considerations for Students with Disabilities and many more!

The <u>Alfred Street Baptist Church 21<sup>st</sup> Annual HBCU Festival</u> will be held on November 17-18, 2023. Approximately 80 Historically Black Colleges and Universities will be represented, many providing on-site admissions, music auditions, and waived application fees. Seminars help students navigate the college application process, financial aid and acclimate them to campus life. In 2022, nearly \$4 million in scholarships were awarded to high school seniors in attendance, many of whom were first generation college students.
