<u>Radford just announced a direct admit program</u> for students with a weighted GPA of 3.3 or higher and a passing grade in Algebra 2. Nursing applicants must also have a passing grade in either Biology and Chemistry or Anatomy & Physiology. Music and Dance majors must have a successful audition in their respective program to be admitted to their major.

<u>VCU announced a new guaranteed university admission program</u> for first-year freshmen who have a weighted GPA of 3.5 or higher. Note that some programs, such as arts and engineering, will have major-specific requirements and are not eligible for this program. Check out the <u>FAQ</u> for more details.
