Register to Take Two Tuition-free College Courses with NOVA - [NOVA Early Online College \(EOC\)](#) allows **rising high school juniors and seniors** the opportunity to take up to two tuition-free college courses. EOC courses for the fall semester take place from September 23 through December 17. Students should register by **Friday, July 26, at 5 p.m.**

EOC courses are asynchronous, online, and for **college credit only**. Thirteen courses are offered along with courses that fulfill the [IT Technical Support Career Studies Certificate](#). EOC courses meet the requirements for most of NOVA's associate degrees as well as being highly transferable as general education requirements for most universities.
