The Postsecondary Opportunities for High School Students webpage and Level Up Virginia website contain information for students on preparing, applying, and paying for college, as well as information on degrees and labor market career projections.

Registration is now open for the <u>World Languages Credit by Exam</u>. The registration closes on Friday, October 4, 2024. The exam assesses proficiency in a language other than English and can help students earn up to three world language credits. These credits can be applied toward meeting the world language requirement for the Advanced Diploma and may help students earn the Biliteracy Seal on their diploma. Students interested in registering for the exam should complete the <u>consent form</u> and send it to their school counselor to finalize the registration process.
