While the FAFSA will not open until Dec. 1, seniors and their parents are encouraged to secure an FSA ID now in preparation for completing the FAFSA. Students who are ineligible to complete the FAFSA should plan to fill out the Virginia Alternative State Aid Application (VASA), which will also open in December. If you are unsure whether to file the FAFSA or VASA, please visit Level Up Virginia for information.

Notes from this week's sessions:

Butler University is opening a new **direct admit** <u>Bachelor of Science in Nursing</u> program in fall 2025. Students who apply by Nov. 1 get full consideration for academic scholarships up to \$30K across all majors. Additionally, students will be screened for the **full tuition** <u>Morton-Finney Diversity Scholar Award</u> which seeks students with strong academics as well as a commitment to promote diversity and inclusion through high school and community activities.

VCU offers **guaranteed admission** for students with a 3.5 GPA. Review the details here.

Radford renewed their <u>Tuition Promise</u> for students whose families have an adjusted gross income of \$100K or less and a Student Aid Index of less than \$15K as determined by the FAFSA. Direct admission is available for freshman applicants with a 3.3 GPA and a passing grade in Algebra 2. Students and families can explore campus, meet faculty and support services, and learn about admissions and financial aid at the **Open House** on Oct. 19. Register here.
