<u>Launch to College</u> provides support and information to help students as they transition from high school to college and post-secondary opportunities. **Seniors and juniors** can join the <u>Launch to College Schoology page</u> (Access code: **HHVQ-FTHG-QZ5S4)**. Participants receive reminders about important college-related and post-secondary deadlines, learn from a variety of subject-matter experts, fine tune their time management skills, and learn strategies to overcome different challenges. The primary vehicle for Launch to College is Schoology and will begin in January 2025. There are virtual office hours, both synchronous and asynchronous presentations, and weekly updates. *Participation is voluntary*.
