Learn how college admissions offices make decisions and what colleges look for in an applicant. Meet NOVA Counselor Ms. Liguid and discuss NOVA's degree programs, cost of attendance, application requirements, and more! Ms. Liguid will also set up a table in the cafeteria during all lunches for students who are unable to attend or need to follow up with questions.

The new <u>Radford Tuition Promise</u> will cover the tuition of Virginia residents whose families have an adjusted gross income of \$100K or less. The goal is for current and prospective students to know they have an affordable pathway to a high-quality education.

<u>Recordings of Virtual College Week</u> presentations are now available. Under Schedule of Events, click on each date to see the workshop title and description and zoom recordings. Topics include Paying for college, Exploring Naviance Student, Military 101, Standardized Testing, Scholarship 101, NOVA, and more! The <u>NOVA presentation is also offered in Spanish</u>.

The **ASVAB** is a timed multi-aptitude test, which is given at over 14,000 schools and Military Entrance Processing Stations (MEPS) nationwide. It is a helpful career assessment tool which is developed and maintained by the Department of Defense. **There is no obligation to join the military if you choose to take the ASVAB. It is** *required if you plan to enlist* in the military. Juniors and seniors must <u>complete this form</u> if you would like to take the ASVAB at Centreville High School on Tuesday, November 28 at 8:10am.

The <u>Common App Direct Admissions</u> program significantly expanded this year to include 70 colleges and 200,000 admission offers based on reported grades. Emails were sent on Tuesday from Common App specifically focusing on first generation college students or families with significant financial need. If a student is notified, **they will still need to finish their common app but can do so with the assurance that they will be admitted.**
