

x2VOL

x2VOL is the tool that FCPS middle and high schools use to support students with finding, tracking and verifying service hours electronically. Students login to x2VOL through this Naviance link on the FCPS website.

Students must use x2VOL to get credit for their service learning hours.

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Students who fulfill at least 40 hours of service learning by May 1 of their graduation year will receive a black service learning cord to wear at graduation. Students who fulfill at least 50 hours and meet additional requirements may apply for The Board of Education's Seal for Excellence in Civics Education. Students must use x2VOL to get credit for their service learning hours.






3. Scroll down on the Naviance home page and click on the x2VOL box.
