The popular **Junior Panel** will be held on **Wednesday, March 13 for the Class of 2025**. Students will attend a daytime session during ROAR and PLUS 5. **Parents, guardians, and students are invited to attend the evening presentation at 7pm in the CVHS auditorium.** The panel features representatives from **NOVA, ACE Apprenticeships, GMU, Virginia Tech and University of Wisconsin**. The focus is on post-secondary options, including apprenticeships, community college, and 4-year universities. Expert advice will be shared regarding managing the research and application process, financial aid and scholarships, and more!
